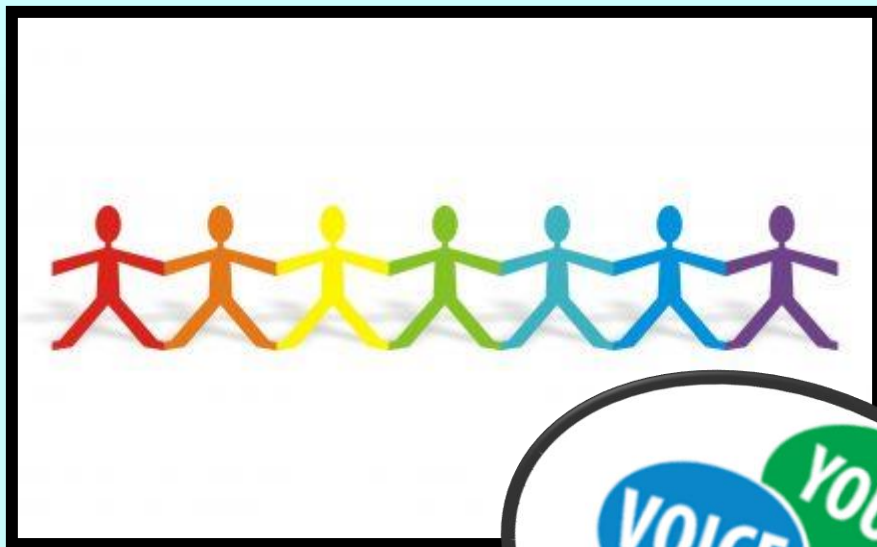


# Journey Leaders Assemble!





### Who are Journey Leaders?

*Places will then be allocated accordingly.*

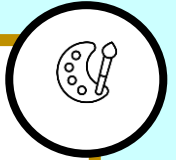


Can I be on the School Council and in a Journey Leader Team?

## Creation Champions

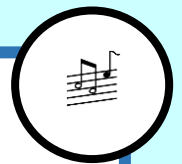


Do you love our planet? Are you ready to make a difference to our world?

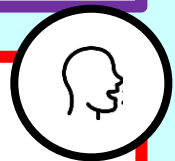
## St James Spirit Party

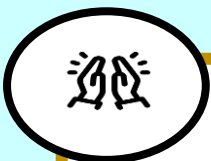
Come and join a celebration of what makes us special.
