Employ a male teacher	When recruiting school looks for outstanding practitioners. To provide positive male role models school are developing relationships with outside agencies to meet this need.
Ensure children are listened to	School have a number of councils which children are actively involved in. These include school council, ethos club and eco council. These groups now also meet after school. Children take on more responsibility with jobs such as prefects etc.
End of year reports given out in March/April	School has now introduced termly reports for parents which are discussed during parent meetings. End of year reports will be sent home at the end of the academic year

Governors visit school on open evenings as well as through the day and report on their activities. These reports can be found in the Governor's visit books and on the website.
