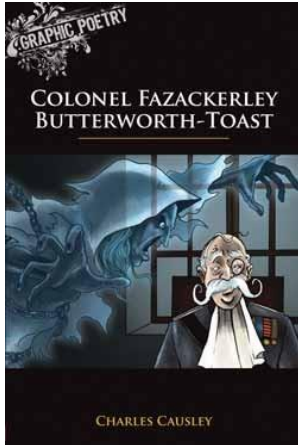

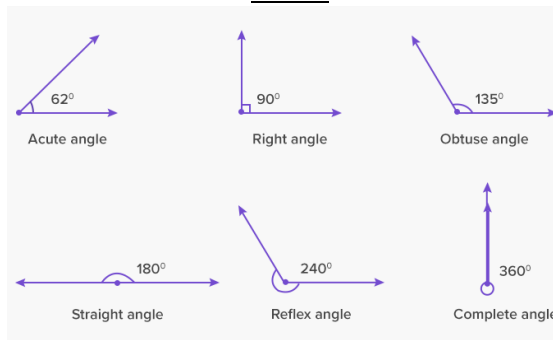


### Narrative Poems
