English: In our English lessons we have been writing a persuasive speech. The children have been very impressive with their use of modal verbs and rhetorical questions.

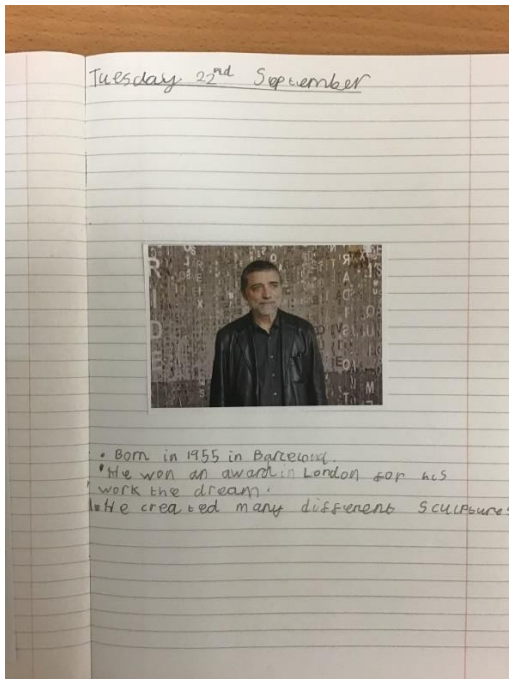
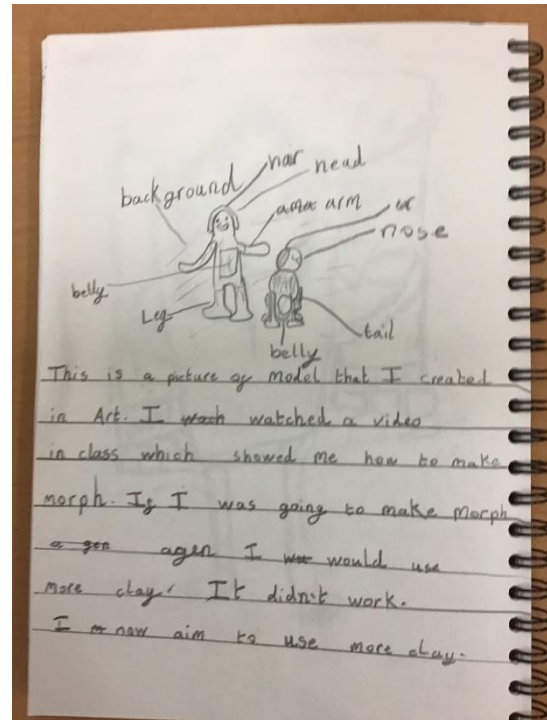
Maths: We have been practising our addition and subtraction and developing our mastery of these concepts, by considering the different strategies that we can use.
