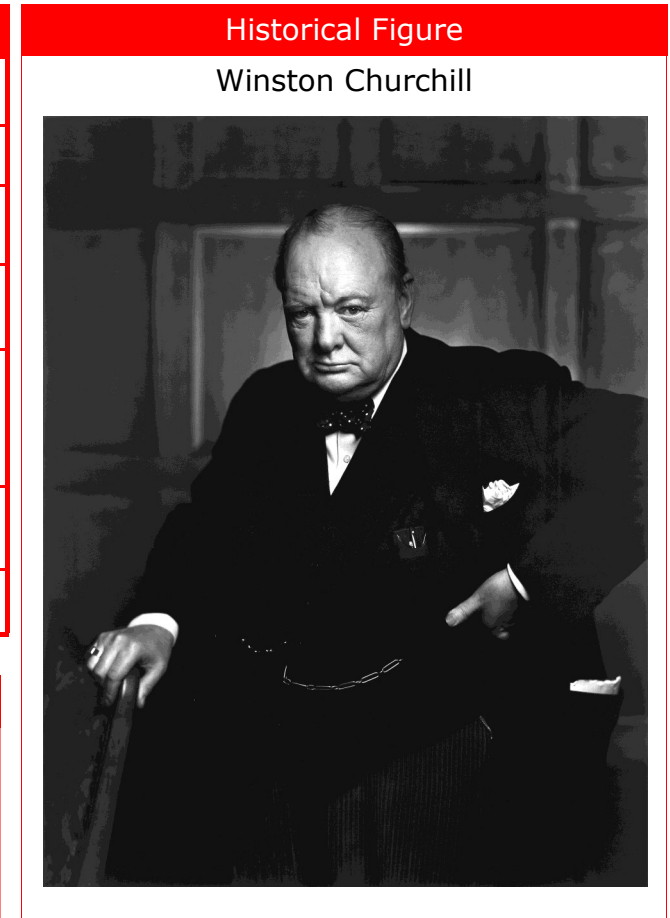




Knowledge Organiser History Year 3 How did World War 2 affect the lives of children?

Key Vocabulary	
World War	A war involving many large nations in all different parts of the world.
Invade	Armed forces enter a country or region to occupy it.
Impact	A marked effect or influence.
Ammunition	A supply or quantity of bullets and shells.
Blackout	A period when all lights must be turned out or covered to prevent them being seen by the enemy.
Air raid	An attack in which bombs are dropped from aircraft on to a ground tar-
Evacuee	A person evacuated from a place of danger.



Key knowledge

1. WW2 started on the 3rd September 1945 and ended in 1945.
2. The war started with Germany invading nearby countries and Hitler led them.
3. Winston Churchill led us through the war.
4. Many children were evacuated during the war and moved to safer places in the countryside.
5. Evacuees took a gas mask, change of clothes, underwear, toiletries, handkerchiefs and a warm coat.
