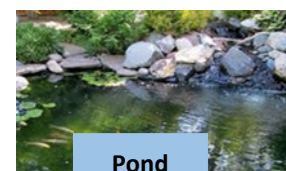
## Key Vocabulary

Consumer	a consumer eats producers or other consumers in a food chain
Producer	An organism that makes its own food, such as a
Habitat	a place that an animal or plant lives. It provides the animal or plant with food, water and shelter
Environment	The area in which something exists or lives.
Microhabitat	A very small, specific habitat for animals and plants
Organism	A living thing
Producer	An organism that makes its own food, such as a plant
Shelter	A place giving temporary protection from bad weather or danger.
Alive	A living thing is alive. It is called an organism.  
Dead	A dead thing has once been alive.  

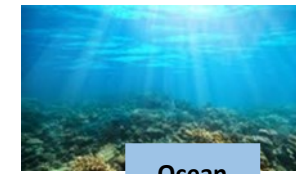

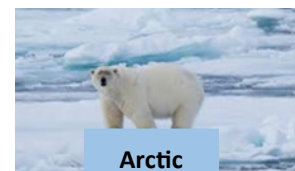
Forest



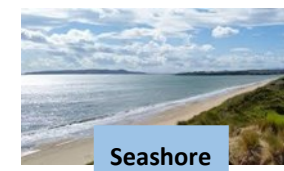
Pond



Ocean

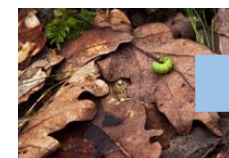

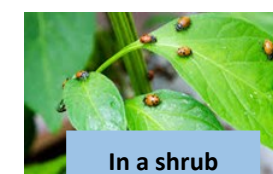
## Examples of microhabitats
