What miracles did Elijah perform? What happened at the end of the story – how did God show Elijah that he appreciated his work?</p> <p>Challenge: Before starting the task, read the story of Elijah from the Bible to make sure you understand it. (There are a few versions online – this is a good link: <u>Elijah and the Prophets of Baal</u>)</p> <p>Your task... To write a short speech of something that Elijah would have said to the evil Prophets and evil King.
